| <br>Enhanced PPE       | <p>We may be wearing scrub caps, gowns, face shields, and specialized masks, depending on the procedure.</p>   | <br>Streamlined appointments | <p>We may be brief in conversation and there may be less 'show and tell' than you're used to. We are always happy speak to you on the phone after your appointment, as needed.</p> |
| <br>Enhanced screening | <p>Everyone entering our clinic (including staff) will be screened for symptoms of/exposure to COVID-19 and have their temperature taken.</p>  | <br>Physical distancing      | <p>There will be fewer people in the office at any given time, and physical distancing will be in place whenever possible.</p>   |
| <br>Disinfection     | <p>Our office has always had strict disinfection protocols in the clinical areas. We have enhanced our cleaning protocol to include disinfection of commonly touched surfaces such as door handles and the front desk counter.</p> <p>We have removed the fabric waiting room chairs and replaced them with wipeable chairs.</p> |                            | <p>We require the use of hand sanitizer upon entry and prior to exiting the clinic.</p> <p>Patients will be asked to use an anti-viral mouth rinse upon arrival.</p>               |
